Meat (Beef) Extract	5,000
Yeast Extract	1,000
Peptone from Meat	5,000
Sucrose	5,000
Magnesium Sulfate, Anhydrous*	240

* The molarity of the magnesium sulfate is equivalent to the amount used in the heptahydrate (MgSO₄*7H₂O) form. The anhydrous form is used to minimize the water content in the dry powder medium.

Application Notes:

Adjust to pH 7.2 after dissolving in water and autoclave. This medium has been used extensively to culture *Agrobacterium* species.
